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“The Hour Is Here”

--The 2009 Jumproom Preface

“Jumproom” is a contemporary term for what science fiction writers used to call “time machines.” I'm not a science fiction writer, but I do happen to have a Jumproom. Let's take a jump to the year 2059....

So ... here we are at the great University of Cascadia at Tacoma. It is September 7th 2059. We're standing in front of the Old World Studies building. Let's go in ... to Auditorium 5. Here we are. Note that over the door to this auditorium are inscribed the words “The Hour Is Here.” Do you know the source of this phrase? Yes. The Hopi elders. For a long time, the Hopi elders had been warning the peoples of the Old World (our world) that it was the 11th hour. In '07, they declared that “the hour is here.”

As it so happens, a lecture on the shift from Old to New worlds is now in progress. It's titled “The Big Change—from the Bottom Up.” The speaker is Dr. David Owen, a specialist in a field called “templatology”--the study of the ideological bases of societies and civilizations....

“The history of our species on this planet in the closing centuries of the Old World, especially the twentieth century, is shocking indeed. As the poet says, 'Fear was in the saddle and rode mankind.' When fear is in the saddle, as you know, the rational faculties shut down and the body's energy goes into fight or flight—or cowering in a corner.

“I myself use a different metaphor to describe the situation of Old World humans ... they were not playing with a full deck. Missing from their deck of paradigms were the Oneness cards, cards signifying the three metaphysical laws on which New World is built: The One is all, all are One; that which exists will always exist; and what you put forth is what comes back to you.

“What is the basis of these three laws? Oneness physics, which was termed in the Old World the 'holographic theory of universe.' The Oneness paradigm, or life vision, made its scientific debut in the early twentieth century with the theoretics of Walter Russell and others.

These theoretics were generally ignored, but in the late part of the century, a theory of the Oneness of universe was published that could not be ignored. The author was physicist David Bohm, and the publication was titled *Wholeness and the Implicate Order*.

“In subsequent years, many confirmations of the Bohm theory were advanced, but these came too late in the game to assist the species in confronting the Great Transition [Y2K8-12] rationally. It was only after the Transition that the Big Change in the mass consciousness occurred. Within ten years, the Oneness paradigm became the generally accepted paradigm on Earth. As the great truth that 'we are all related in the Oneness' spread, humanity ceased being a fear-based species.

“That we even have a human species today is the result of a considerable number of Old Worlders who inspired others to remember and to re-activate the power of the Oneness within.

“The auditorium we are in commemorates the work of an important group of those Old Worlders—the Hopi elders. Throughout the Old World epoch, which the Hopi termed the 'Fourth World,' the elders followed instructions for life given them by their great spiritual teacher, Massaw, after the destruction of the Third World by flood. In the words of Dan Evehema, one of the last of the elders, 'We are instructed to hold this world in balance within the land and many universes with special prayers and ritual' Our world owes much to the Hopi wisdom keepers.

“In his life time, Evehema witnessed sign after sign that the transition from Fourth to Fifth worlds would be a hard one. Nevertheless, until the time of his death, he appealed to the peoples of the world to end their conflicts and join together as family. In his words: 'Now we must look upon each other as brothers and sisters. There is no more time for divisions between people.... These divisions will not be our salvation. Wars only bring more wars, never peace.'

“In 1997, the wisdom of the Hopi elders was fully articulated in a book authorized by Dan Evehema and written by Thomas E. Mails—*The Hopi Survival Kit*, sub-titled *The Prophecies, Instructions, and Warnings Revealed by the Last Elders*. This book, as you probably know, is now regarded one of the key documents of the Great Transition.

“Unbeknownst to Dan Evehema and most Hopi, western science was, at the turn of the century, catching up with Native American wisdom. In 2010, Dr. Bruce Lipton took the celebrated Gaia hypothesis a step further, by arguing that planet Earth is sentient as well as singular. Lipton's 'Mother Earth hypothesis,' as it was called at the time, played a major role in the post-2012 period of the Big Change. For the first time, all peoples of Earth came to

understand, scientifically, that Earth is a sentient super-organism and that humans are, physiologically, components of that organism.”

Back the present! Hope you enjoyed your quick trip to 2059. What's that?--you've got a question? Shoot.

“Your previous writings suggest that you give a good deal of credence to the so-called crop circles....”

“Credence? Yes. Many of the formations express or encode complex scientific information. That's a simple fact. The credibility issue arises in connection with the messenger, not the messages. Who or what created the formations?--which have appeared all over the world. You've no doubt heard a number of theories as to the messenger or messengers. Here's one you probably have not heard: The formations, or most of them, have been created by Mother Earth. If we allow that Earth is sentient, we're saying she's just like you and I. You and I can decorate ourselves a few tattoos, no? So can Mother. Contemplate that, and please ... continue with your question.”

“If the Longwood Warren Solar System formation is correct, then there will be no Earth in 2059. Earth will have been obliterated by 2033.”
